Together with experienced Suzuka Meister Gregory Leblanc, Kawasaki Webike Trickstar welcomed 2 Suzuka rookies this season, Italian Christian Gamarino who already tested Suzuka once a month ago and Spanish Roman Ramos who never had ran this technical circuit.

The weekend was extremely warm and the riders had been struggled the whole weekend to adapt this exceptional condition especially 2 rookies who have never experienced such extreme heat in Europe. For 2 qualifying sessions on Saturday, the track condition was critical as the air temperature raised to 33° C and track temperature was more than 50° C, but the riders tried with the race tyres to be ready for the race.

At the first qualify, blue rider Leblanc scored 2.08' 241 at his second lap and kept pushing, but the session stopped by the red flag.

The team had decided not to continue the session for the purpose of saving the tyres for the other riders after red flag.

He tried to improve his lap time on his 2nd qualify session but he was not able to make it happen and his best lap time remained from the 1st qualify.

Rider yellow Gamarino started his 1st session with the tyres Leblanc had used in the previous session and scored 2.8' 895 on his second lap.

But so did for the previous session of the red rider, this session had stopped by red flag.

He went back to the track after the red flag got cleared and improved his lap time down to 2.8' 688. He respectfully continued to improve his lap times in his second qualify either, and scored 2.8' 414 as his best qualify time.

As missing the pre test in Suzuka due to the calendar crash with Spanish Championship, red rider Roman Ramons had discovered Suzuka circuit only a few days before, he' d decided to spend his first qualify session to set up the bike and get to be ready for his second qualify.

The track temperature dropped down a bit when his session started at 17:03 which meant that the condition got slightly better to attack, and this had allowed him to score 2.8' 397, amazing lap time for Suzuka rookie who had only made few laps during the weekend.

The team final qualifying time is set 2.08' 319 which is the average lap time of 2 fastest riders in the team Leblanc and Ramos, 18th starting position over all.















RACE (DNF)

Race day was the hottest day during the week, and the whole paddock was suffered by the heat from early morning.

Kawasaki Webike Trickstar was not able to get the ideal starting position as wished but had good confidence for the race since the team had been working hard to focus for the race under this extreme heat so that the

whole team was highly motivated on Sunday morning. In the morning warm up session, the bike set up improved and Leblanc had made a few laps with the fast and consistent pace having comfortable feeling.

But while he stayed pushing on the track, he had an unfortunate crash and got injured.

Considering his injury, the circuit doctor decided "unfit" for him to continue the event and he was forced to be withdraw for the race.

This had forced the team to change the team strategy for the race which is startingin a few hours, and 2 remaining riders needed to complete 8 hours without having Gregory.

Starting rider for this Suzuka 8 Hours is decided Gamarino who had never experienced to be a starting rider in the team since his debut to the team in 2024.

Starting from 18th position, Gamarino had lost some positions but soon picked up again and raised his position to 15th at Lap3.

He had kept the good pace and picked up one more position at Lap7. To take the advantage of the good fuel consumption of KWT,

Gamarino had stayed on the track a few laps more after most of the team had already done the pit stop and this had brought the team to raise the position up to 5th before the first pit stop. When Ramos went out from

the box to the track, he found himself at 14th position over all and he kept running with the consistent pace. Although when suddenly his pace got visibly dropped and the team was wondering what was happening,

Ramos fell on the team' s 53rd lap, but he picked up the bike immediately and came into the box.

Immediately after he brought his bike to the pit-lane, he fell down on the ground and lost conscious for seconds. He was sent to the circuit medical center to check up, and be found that having dehydration syndrome.

KWT already had only 2 riders which had meant that it was impossible to continue the race only by Gamarino, but Gamarino tried to give all his best to the limit until the EWC regulation allowed. KWT never had declared "Retire", and continued till the end.

Ramos, who was recovering from dehydration showed the intention to continue also, team had decided to complete the last session by him to pass the checkered flag.

KWT had only completed 123 laps which was not considered to complete the race, although both of the riders and every single person in the team gave their all to this event and gained so much data for the future. It was not the result the team and the riders wanted, but this is the race.

Now KWT starts to get to be prepared for the last round in Bold' or in September.
